# An introduction to incorporating child play as a communication tool into healthcare

# Early Childhood Attachment (Recorded Webinar) (1 hr)

The first relationships of an infant's life provides a blueprint for bonding and subsequent attachment relationships. It is important to understand and recognise attachment behaviours as coping strategies because these are key in understanding how the child may avoid or seek information and interactions. This webinar provides an overview of the historical development of attachment theory and integrates current knowledge in working with a range of childhood attachment behaviours.

# Session 1 - Review Psychosocial and Play Development (2 hrs)

Understanding the ages and stages of childhood and play enables the Nurse to tailor care and interactions according to the child's developmental abilities. In this session, we will review the general stages of psychosocial and play development for children from birth to adolescents. Practical examples will be offered and linked to significant developmental stages.

# Session 2 - Pre-reading Play (1 hr)

You will be provided with pre-reading material and videos that explore the elements of play, that are required to be completed before the next afternoon session.

#### Session 3 - Explore the Concept of Play (2 hrs)

During this session, we will identify what is play (and what is not) and discover the categories of play and how play becomes therapeutic and used in ways that empower the child. During this session, there will be facilitated activities to watch videos and deconstruct children at play.

### Session 1 - Introduction to Therapeutic Play Skills (1hr)

This webinar identifies and describes a range of therapeutic play skills suitable for working with children in health care settings. It is important preparation for Session 2.

# Session 2 - Interactive Experiential Putting Play Skills into Action (2 hrs)

This session builds on the webinar 'Introduction to Therapeutic Play Skills' where you will practice setting the conditions and practice using five different therapeutic play skills. Through the use of clinical scenarios and case studies, you will be given the opportunity to practise these skills through role play.

#### Session 3 - Why Procedural Preparation is so Important. (Recorded Webinar) (1hr)

This webinar makes a case for procedural preparation and how incorporating it into your care can improve patient readiness, reduce anxiety and actually save time in the longer term. It is preparatory for session 4.

#### Session 4 - Preparing Children for Procedures (2 hrs)

A large part of the Nurse's role is preparing the child and their family for potential scary and or painful procedures. The use of comfort positioning and distraction techniques are paramount to the success of many medical procedures. In this session, you will learn how to adequately prepare a child for a range of procedures using age-appropriate language. You will also learn how to tailor a comfort position according to each individual's needs and select methods of distraction to align their developmental stage.


