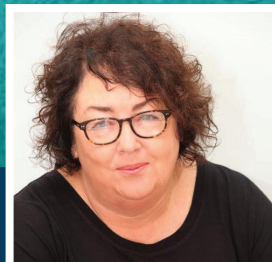

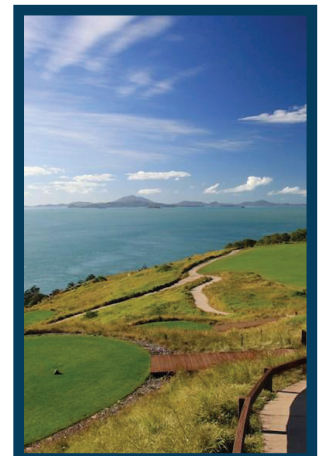
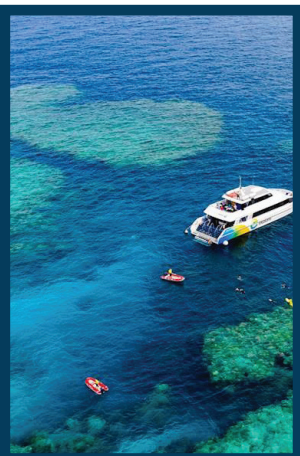
### SUE WALKER
