


# Puerto Maldonado Amazon Lodge

Day 2 : 5th August 2025





The history of Traditional midwifery in Colombia and Peru, the ancestrality of taking care of women.

Learn what it means in Colombia to be a "partera" who engage in a centuries-old tradition, accompanying women not just during birth but before and after, teaching them how to care for themselves, their babies, and encouraging them to visit healthcare clinics when its required.

We will visit a local hospital and see how Midwifery is handled in Colombia and the challenges they face. We will review the similarities and differences – this is an opportunity to learn from each other.



## Day 3 : 6th August 2025

#### **Reflection Day:**



Take the day to explore and reflect on on the previous day's content. Explore the historic Walled City of Cartagena. Wander through colonial architecture and sample the local food.

#### **Afternoon: Sunset Cruise including Drinks**



We will enjoy an evening watching the sunset over Cartagena.

Cruise 1.5-hour through the peaceful waters of Cartagena's Bay while enjoying the beautiful sunset, magnificent skyline and the colonial city views.

Relax, and enjoy quality time together, sipping on beer, wine, or cocktails like rum punch as you watch the sun go down.

# Day 4: 7th August 2025

#### **Morning:**



Fly to Cusco and transfer to our hotel.

We will meet a midwife and herbalist who is an expert in traditional midwifery and medicine.

# Day 5 : 8th August 2025

# Cusco mountain Bike (Bus option available)



After a 55 minute drive we will arrive in the Inca town of Chinchero, here we will visit the archaeological site and textile house. Next stop will be the Salt mines of Maras and then onto the Inca circular terraces of Moray. A bus ride will take us to the top of the mountain to start our Mountain Bike adventure to the nice native town of Huarocondo. Here the people still wear traditional clothing and the town is lined with historical buildings. Our final stop will be the biggest terraces of Zurite.



After our downhill bike ride we will have an Andean picnic lunch with a bottle of wine to celebrate this fantastic journey, before heading back to our hotel.







#### Day 7: 10th August 2025

#### Sacred Valley & Machu Picchu Tour





We will be picked up around 7 a.m. and drive to Pisac to see the first Inca ruins of the tour. At Pisac you can see magnificent Inca remains. The ancient architecture and engineering of the Inca temples is breathtaking and will sweep you off your feet.

Then we will head back to the valley to visit the most colorful and traditional local market in Cusco region and where you can buy traditional textiles at low prices. After our visit to the market our sightseeing continues as we drive along the beautiful Sacred Valley.

Our next destination is Urubamba. We will arrive there at around 12pm. In this stunning town you will have the opportunity to choose one of the many delicious local restaurants to have lunch (not included).

From Urubamba we will drive 30 minutes to get to the last Inca ruins on our tour, known as Ollantaytambo (Inca palace). This ruin was built with pink granite rocks and is another impressive example of Inca craftsmanship.

Here you can see the second biggest rock from the Inca times (90 tons) which was used as part of the Temple of the Sun. we will have a guided tour of the site.

After we will head to the train station, which is 15 minutes by foot. We will take the Vistadome train to Aguas Calientes.

During this trip you will see many glaciers and snow-capped peaks, lush, green valleys and Incan farming terraces on both sides of the valley.

Upon arrival to Aguas Calientes you will check in to our hotel.

The natural hot springs in town are an unbeatable way to spend a late afternoon/early evening if time is available before dinner. Dinner will be at a local restaurant.



# Day 8 : 11th August 2025

# Sacred Valley & Machu Picchu Tour Continued...



After breakfast, we will take a very early bus along the winding road to Machu Picchu, the Inca city that was lost to the jungle but rediscovered in 1911 by Hiram Bingham. Declared a UNESCO world heritage site in 1983, Machu Picchu exceeds all expectations.

Perched high on an inaccessible hilltop the citadel is protected by huge cliffs and the raging Urubamba River. Once there you will be given a 2-hour guided walking tour of the site.

Our expert guide who will explain the history of this ancient Inca citadel will make you back in the time by taking you to the most interesting areas of the citadel. After your your Machu Picchu tour, you will have some time to be at Machu Picchu before you return to Aguas Calientes.

Day 9 : 12th August 2025

# Fly from Cusco to Puerto Maldonado:



#### **Tambopata Amazon Rainforest:**

We will travel to our jungle house, located on the Tambopara river. Check in to your cabin then set off for your first jungle tour!

We will walk for about 2 kilometers through the jungle looking for monkeys, brown agoutis, and butterflies as you learn about the trees and plants which grow there.

When the sun goes down, we will begin our night adventure on the river, to go in search of caimans and capybaras and learn all about the animals.

Day 10 : 13th August 2025

# Lake Sandoval, Amazon Jungle:

We will visit Lake Sandoval which is located in the heart of Tambopata National Reserve. Here, observe the many bird species, caimans, turtles, monkeys, and giant otters that live here.



Later, head into the rainforest at night, following your guide through the dark jungle in search of night monkeys, tarantulas, frogs, insects, and other nocturnal animals.

# Day 11 : 14th August 2025



#### Monkey Island, Amazon Jungle:

Today we embark on a kayaking adventure! Heading downstream to the Monkey Island.

Once we land on the island, we will go for a walk searching for monkeys and observe them in their native environment.

Enjoy the opportunity to feed and take pictures with them.

After lunch, we will visit a visit local indigenous community and Health care centre.

# Day 12 : 15th August 2025



#### **Tambopata Amazon Rainforest:**

Today we start early and head to the clay lick to see the parakeets, parrots and 2 species of small macaws.

On the way back, search for sloths. After breakfast, your guide will take you to the perfect spot for bird watching and take you for piranha sport fishing.
